Clara Gerdes, from Davidson, NC, is a fourth year student at the Curtis Institute in Philadelphia where she studies organ with Alan Morrison and harpsichord with Leon Schelhase. She has won several organ playing competitions, including the Mid-Atlantic Quimby Young Organists Competition, the Albert Schweitzer Competition, and the University of North Carolina School of the Arts Organ Competition. She was the recipient of the first annual American Guild of Organists Pogorzelski-Yankee scholarship. This past summer, she performed at the AGO National Convention and in Alaska. Clara is an organ scholar at St. Mark's Episcopal Church, Philadelphia, an assistant organist at the Wanamaker organ, and performs with area early music ensembles.
